


Fr George Florovsky and the Neo-Patristic synthesis

On Thursday 21 February, Revd. Prof. Andrew Louth will treat the Fr George Florovsky in his sixth lecture of the two-year course The Ways of Modern Orthodox Theology. Born in Russia in 1893, Fr George taught patristics at St Sergius Theological Institute in Paris and was Dean of St Vladimir's Seminary in New York. Thereafter he taught at Harvard Divinity School and at Princeton University. He was active in the ecumenical movement and a prolific writer. His name is associated with the so-called Neo-Patristic synthesis.
